SVP provides educational and recreational activities and services to children under 18 years of age nationally through our network of Regions and local Conferences.

SVP is committed to safeguarding children by working under the guidance of our national safeguarding policies and procedures. Our members, non-member volunteers and staff are committed to creating a safe environment for children and young people to grow and develop.

Each SVP Children's Activity or Service will conduct a specific written risk assessment and child safeguarding statement in line with Children First Act 2015, Protection for Persons Reporting Child Abuse Act 1998, NVB Act 2012 and 2016, Children First Guidance 2017 and Tusla Guidance on Developing a Child Safeguarding Statement.

**Service Description:** A Resource Centre providing activities for children in direct provision, an intergenerational programme and a homework club as well as older people's service, lunch and social club, training, classes, men's group, fáilte Isteach (conversational english), support to asylum seekers with interviews.

The written risk assessment indicates the areas of potential harm, the likelihood of harm occurring, and lists the required policy, guidance, process and practice required to alleviate the risks. Risks are identified in the following categories:

- Risk of harm of a child by a member of staff, volunteer or peer
- Risk of harm of a child by a visitor to the service
- Risk of harm of a child on outings by a member of staff/volunteer/stranger/peer
- Risk of harm of unauthorised collection of children from Homework Club
- Risk of harm of Information on service and how it is operated not given to Parents
- Risk of harm from bullying of a child by a member of staff/volunteer/peer
- Risk of harm of a child from unauthorised photography
- Risk of harm of a child from online abuse through social media or internet access
- Reporting concerns
- Infections and pandemics

In addition to this service/activity risk assessments the following procedures are in place throughout SVP as part of our safeguarding policies and procedures:

- Procedures for managing allegations of abuse or misconduct by volunteers or employees against a child availing of our services.
- Procedures for the safe recruitment of volunteers or employees to work with children in our services.
- All staff, CE participants, volunteers and students are provided with child safeguarding training, including the identification and reporting of harm.
- Procedures for reporting child protection and welfare concerns to Statutory Authorities.
- Procedure for maintaining a list of persons in the relevant services who are mandated persons.
- Procedures for appointing a relevant person for the purposes of the Statement.
- All staff with direct contact to children maintain a 2-year Safeguarding training cycle which includes the trainings required in Tusla's Child Safeguarding Training Cycle.

SVP Croí na Gaillimhe recognises that implementation is an ongoing process – we are committed to the implementation of this Child Safeguarding Statement and the procedures that support our intention to keep children safe from harm.
